MATAGORDA CROSSING RAIL TERMINAL

Matagorda Crossing Rail Terminal sits at a crossroad of major pipeline and railroad connectivity 7 miles southeast of the Markham Salt Dome. This underdeveloped deep basin salt dome is poised to be the next major source of energy production along the Texas Coast.



WHY MATAGORDA CROSSING?

Expanding Houston's logistics infrastructure, especially for rail and salt cavern storage, is becoming more complex – resulting in discussions on whether to develop other Texas Gulf Coast outlets. The existing Markham salt dome represents the closest location with deep, high-quality salt to handle storage for all Permian NGL streams. In addition, South Texas is an under-served and growing petrochemical feedstock market that will value new light hydrocarbon feedstock sources due to its proximity to the Permian Basin and an air permit Attainment Zone.
